


To bring help, hope and healing to a minimum of 5,000 communities by 2045

# What is Integration? Bringing the best of all of us for greater impact



#### How does MAF International work now?

The MAF International family is made up of our operational programmes and 13 resourcing groups.




**Operations** = places where we serve isolated people. Flying the planes, and supporting the people who fly the planes!



**Resourcing groups** = groups who raise money and recruit people for operations. They keep our planes in the air!

# What is Integration? Bringing the best of all of us for greater impact



#### So, what's the problem?

Resourcing groups are separate organisations. They all have their own finance, HR and marketing departments - and their own finance, HR and marketing policies and standards!


They also vary in size - some are big and have lots of expertise, some are small and are trying to achieve big things with few people - they need help!

Operations relies on resourcing groups to send people and money. But it means that it's hard to recruit and receive funds from places where there is no resourcing group.

It also means that the people doing the work are not able to easily make decisions about the work and how to resource it.

All these things make it hard to work together - even when we want to! Something needs to change!


# What is integration? Bringing the best of all of us for greater impact



#### Why will this help?


- **Joined up finances** we will be able to make better decisions on how our money is spent.
- One people strategy we can recruit and onboard new staff quicker, care for them better and keep them for longer, resulting in less staff shortages.
- Raising more funds by presenting ourself as one big organisation rather than multiple small organisations, we will be able to access bigger funding opportunities, which means serving more isolated people, better.
- **Better systems** when we are all on one system, we can access better data more easily and communicate with one another better, no matter where we are! This means more efficient working and better decision making.




